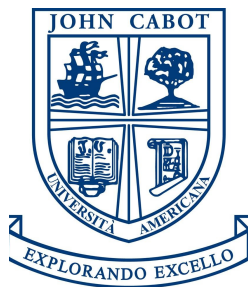
The Society seeks to examine what is going on in the world through academic discussions and informal conversations, including all members of the JCU community.

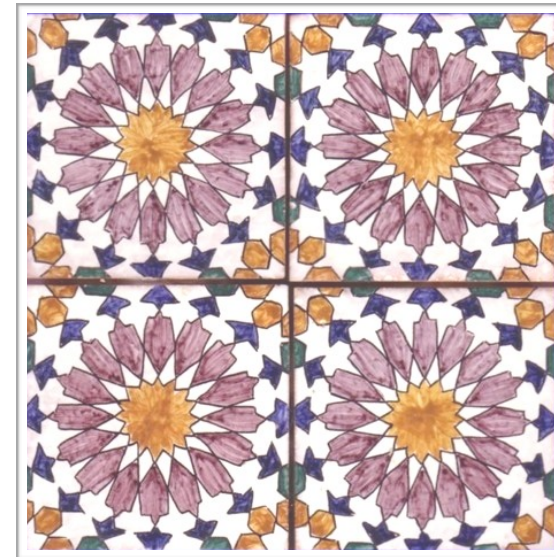
