### Summer Institute - Session 1

#### Creative Writing and Literary Translation

### Summer Institute - Session 2

#### International Communication

The Institute for International Communication brings together students and faculty from around the world to study communication in the home of Cicero. Past Institutes have examined the role of money in political communication; rhetoric in political agenda-setting; journalists and the Vatican; and the image of women in the media. The session ends with a lively public speaking tournament.



## Living in Rome

Located in Trastevere, an enchanting neighborhood along the Tiber River, John Cabot is minutes from Vatican City and steps from Piazza di Santa Maria and Rome's bustling center.

Students reside in a secure, furnished, and air conditioned residence hall close to classrooms, the library, dining hall, and fitness facility. Mixing with Roman residents, students become immersed in Italian culture, visiting museums and open-air markets and using their blossoming Italian vocabulary while dining al fresco at nearby cafes.



### L'Estate Romana

An added benefit of summering in Rome is access to "L'Estate Romana," a series of music, film, arts, and other cultural performances held throughout the city for Romans and tourists alike.

### Travel

Classes are held Monday through Thursday so weekends are free for exploring. European cities including London, Paris, and Athens are an easy train or plane trip away. Even Istanbul, Dubai, and Jerusalem are within reach.
