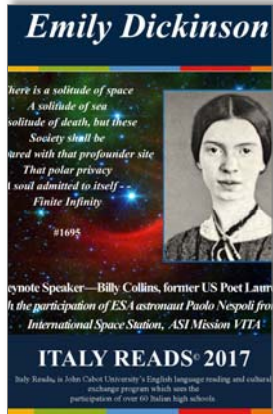

In its 9th year, Italy Reads is JCU's community-based reading program that thrives on a vibrant cultural exchange between students.

Each year we select a different work. We've read:

- Tennessee Williams' *The Glass Menagerie* and



This year we're reading *The Selected Poems of Emily Dickinson*.

JCU's Italy Reads has brought these works of American literature into Italian high school classrooms and discussed (in English) the issues they present. Hundreds of people each year get involved! JCU works with nearly 200 teachers at 65 Italian public high schools in Rome and the nearby community.

What do you do as an Italy Reads volunteer?

- read and prepare to discuss the work of literature,
- meet with other Italy Reads Volunteers and travel to Italian high schools together to discuss the literature and interact with Italian students of English language and literature.
- help them create short videos for the Italy Reads [Video Contest](#).
