



Study abroad scholarship for alumni of the Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy

In support of the mission of the [Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy](#) (AACPA) to bring opportunities for educational excellence to underserved communities and “to produce inspired, creative, ethical, compassionate, and reflective leaders who offer solutions to the problems posed by a democratic society,” John Cabot University is pleased to be able to make available study abroad scholarship for AACPA graduates. The scholarship’s goal is to provide an international experience that further prepares AACPA graduates for positions as community leaders in today’s interconnected world.

Eligibility requirements:

- Graduate of the Andre Agassi College Preparatory Academy;
- Be currently enrolled as a full-time university student at a regionally accredited American university or foreign university recognized by a country’s higher education authority;
- Meet John Cabot University’s visiting student requirements.

Scholarship:

- The scholarship will cover tuition and fees plus JCU housing for one semester or one summer session.
- The recipient will be required to undertake 40 volunteer hours a semester in either community service in Rome or within the University supporting one of JCU’s departments. (12 hours for a summer session). This volunteer service will facilitate the scholarship winner’s involvement in JCU’s community and contribute towards a greater understanding of the educational mission of an American university overseas. The recipient’s volunteer work will be under the direction of the John Cabot University’s Dean’s Office.
- Students will be responsible for their own meals, cost of books, travel, and personal expenses.

Application requirements:

- Complete a regular John Cabot University application for visiting students. (The application fee is waived for students applying for the Andre Agassi – John Cabot University Study Abroad Scholarship) and submit the following [scholarship application](#).
- Official university transcripts.
- A 500 word essay on why the applicant would like to study abroad in Rome, Italy. This can be included in the Essay Section of the on-line application or mailed or faxed to Admissions at John Cabot University in Rome – include your name and that you are applying for the Andre Agassi Scholarship.
- One recommendation letter from a college counselor, professor, or former teacher/counselor from AACPA to be sent or faxed to Admissions at John Cabot University in Rome – the recommendation letter should include the name and title of the writer, how long and in what capacity they have known you, and why they believe your study in Rome would be beneficial to you.
