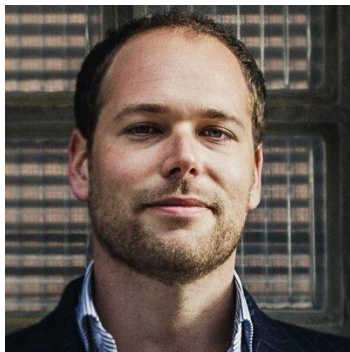


The JCU Institute for Entrepreneurship presents:

Founded by Garrett Goodman and Jaron Collis, QuickLearnr is a social game that enables people around the world to learn a language more quickly and effectively. An idea hatched at a hackathon in London in late 2013, QuickLearnr is being built by a technologist with a PHD in artificial intelligence and an international business development specialist that speaks multiple languages and has lived in 5 countries.

Garrett is currently International New Media and Business Development Consultant at Goodman Consulting. Prior to the establishment of QuickLearnr, Garrett worked at The Huffington Post as Digital Journalism and New Media Blogger focusing on the overlap of innovations in journalism and social media. He also worked as an International Assistant in The New York Times.
