

Secondary Education equivalency chart

Below are some of the more common educational systems that are awarded transfer credits. If you have questions about your own country's educational system, please contact the Registrar at registrar@johncabot.edu for further assistance.

Secondary Educational System	Transfer Credits Awarded
Denmark: Studenterskamen	30 semester credits with a minimum average grade of 9. Credits are granted as general electives.
Norway: Vitnemal – videregående opplæring	30 semester credits with a minimum average grade of 4; credits are granted as general electives.
Finland: Ylioppilastutkintotoimisto / Studentexamensbetyg	30 semester credits with a min. average grade of magna cum laude approbatur (5); credits are granted as general electives.
Sweden: Fullständigt Slutbetyg från Gymnasieskolan	30 semester credits for a minimum average grade of VG (15.00); credits are granted as general electives.
France: Baccalauréat	No credit given; 12 years not 13.
Germany: Abitur	New <i>Abitur</i> taken in Grade 12 so no credit. One year of credit for <i>Abitur</i> taken in 13 th year; must provide final exam results, not just Diploma. Credit awarded for <i>Abitur</i> exam subject (placement required for MA and EN).
