COVID Regional Updates: 23 November 2020

Dear Students,

We hope you are well. We would like to inform you that there have been some changes in the risk classifications of the various Italian Regions.



Yellow: Lazio, Molise, Provincia autonoma di Trento, Sardegna, Veneto.

Orange: Basilicata, Emilia Romagna, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Liguria, Marche, Puglia, Sicilia, Umbria.

Red: Abruzzo, Calabria, Campania, Lombardia, Piemonte, Provincia autonoma di Bolzano, Toscana, Valle d'Aosta.

If you have left/are planning to leave Lazio and intend to return to JCU-campus/JCU-housing before the end of the Fall semester, you must write to deanofstudents@johncabot.edu prior to your return so we can coordinate your re-entry to JCU based on your specific circumstances. You must communicate with the Dean of Students office even if your return is just to pack your belongings. We are asking everyone to do this in order to coordinate any movement on campus or in the residences in a way that keeps everyone safe, informed, and in compliance with government mandates. Please clarify any expectations for quarantine or testing before your return to JCU.

Please note that voluntary movement between yellow regions is highly discouraged.

If you are in an orange or red area you can leave your municipality or region only for essential work, health, and academic needs. If you do travel between regions, you must always have an [autocertificazione](#) on you at all times attesting to your travel motivations.
