

# Appendix A - Casa Scalabrini 634

---

**Casa Scalabrini 634** is located in Rome, in **Via Casilina, 634** and is the operation's center of the **CAI's** project for "**Welcoming and Inclusive Communities**" of the **Scalabrinian Congregation**, active for more than 100 years on migration in over 32 countries. Casa Scalabrini 634 welcomes refugees, both families and young adults, and promotes activities and initiatives open to everyone. The mission is to promote the **welcoming** and **integration of cultures** and it also covers the areas of **awareness, education** and **active citizenship** in schools, companies and other associations.

Among many activities, Casa Scalabrini 634 promotes "**Dialoghi**" (Dialogues), a project to raise awareness of migration issues in schools, churches, companies and other associations in Italy. Dialogues helps students to learn about migration, about the "people on the move" and about the phenomena related to migrants, integration and interculturalism.

Schools that are going to join Dialogues in relation to the Italy Pitches Program, can receive an extra focus in English (*approximately 2 hours*) on non-profit in addition to the meetings already offered in Italian by the project itself (*approximately 5 hours*). Thanks to this extra focus, students will be able to have a better understanding on the non-profit world and therefore they are going to have more information to prepare for their speeches.

By joining the Dialogues project in relation to Italy Pitches, it would be also possible to have recognized 10 hours of **Alternanza Scuola Lavoro (ASL)** directly by Casa Scalabrini 634 (*agreement has to be made between schools and the Association*), broken down as follows:

**Dialogues (in Italian)** 5 hours  
2/3 meetings at the school

**Focus on Non-Profit (in English)** 2 hours  
1 meeting at school

**Refugee for a Day** 3 hours  
Activity/role game to be performed at Casa Scalabrini 634 (Via Casilina, 634 – Rome) that will help students to experience what it means to be a refugee.

Scheduling and planning with the schools has to be discussed with Casa Scalabrini 634.

The project is provided to the schools in Rome and in the Lazio Region: schools outside the region may contact Casa Scalabrini 634 to evaluate feasibility, depending on the location of the school itself.
