Objectives: ASL hours: 10

John Cabot University's [Italy Reads](#) program is an English language community-based reading and cultural exchange program. It provides high school teachers and students of English resources to study an annually selected work of American literature in an active, community-based way. The activities offered by the program contribute to the development of a variety of skills in the student. The results are improved communication skills in English and acquired "life skills" (i.e. cognitive and social skills, emotional and inter-cultural competence). Participation in the annual Italy Reads Student Video Contest provides students with an opportunity to learn "hard skills" such as how to produce a short video inspired by a work of literature.

- REQUIREMENTS:**
1. Student must be an enrolled high school student in Italy in a class that is registered as participating in JCU's Italy Reads.
 2. Student must have at least a level B2 in English. The workshop will be conducted in English by native speakers.
 3. Student must commit to transmit the skills and knowledge acquired at the workshop with his/her peers at school.
