TRANSFER CREDIT INFORMATION
<b>1) For NEW Degree Seeking Students</b>
New incoming students who will provide CLEP Examination scores will be granted credits according to the chart on the right hand side. All CLEP examinations in which the new degree candidate has earned a score of 50 or above will be transferred with a <b>P</b> (passing grade).
<b>2) For current Degree Seeking Students</b>
Current Degree Seeking students who will obtain permission to take CLEP Examinations will be granted credits according to the chart on the right hand side. * <b>All</b> CLEP examinations' results will be transferred and the score will be converted and factored into to student's GPA according to the <b>Grading Equivalency Chart</b> above. (Please note that all CLEP exams in which the student earns a score between 0 and 49 will be transferred with a grade of <b>F</b> )
